Item 5 Approval of Agenda

The President asked for a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made to approve the agenda by Director McCracken and seconded by Director Randles and was carried (5-0).

Item 6 Approval of Minutes

The President called for a motion to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes of October 8, 2020. A motion was made to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes of October 8, 2020 by Director Lloyd and seconded by Director McCracken and carried (5-0).

Item 7 Approval of Treasurer's Reports

It was reported that lightening took out the telemetry. A new sensor was ordered. In the meanwhile, the wells have to be run manually.

The San Francisquito Tank Maintenance Project needed approval of additional work to replace 3 feet of the metal at the roof. The cost estimate was \$15,375.00. A motion was made to approve the additional costs by Director McCracken and seconded by Director Randles and carried (5-0).

10.1 Authorize Merchant Services for credit cards and online payments. Define who pays fees

The District Secretary reported that the Board needed to made a decision as to who would pay the merchant fees of \$1.50 to pay by credit card. A motion was made that the customer would pay the credit card fee by Director McCracken and seconded by Director Randles and carried (5-0).
